## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety.

### AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Plymouth to raise Money to aid in the Reception and Entertainment of the National Convention of the Grand Army of the Republic in August of the current year.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Plymouth is author-  
2 ized to raise by taxation a sum of money not  
3 exceeding one thousand dollars for the purpose  
4 of aiding in the reception and entertainment of  
5 the National Convention of the Grand Army of  
6 the Republic on their proposed visit to Plymouth,  
7 in August of the current year.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
