AN ACT REGULATING THE ELIGIBILITY OF LIFE PRISONERS FOR PAROLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 127 of the General Laws, section 133A,
2 as most recently amended by Chapter 278 of the Acts of 1973, is
3 hereby amended by striking out the words "and except prisoners
4 serving a life sentence for murder in the first degree".

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 127 of the General Laws, section 133A,
2 as most recently amended by Chapter 278 of the Acts of 1973, is
3 hereby amended by striking out the word "fifteen" in line six and
4 inserting in place thereof the following word:— ten.
