

Chap. 279. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 18B of chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the fourth sentence; added by chapter 893 of the acts of 1970.

SECTION 2. Section 25 of said chapter 138 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:—

A holder of a certificate of compliance under the provisions of section eighteen B shall not be construed to be a licensee within the commonwealth under the provisions of this section.

Chap. 280. AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE TERM "ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN" IN THE LAW RELATIVE TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND INDUSTRIAL CORPORATIONS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Subsection (5) of section 1 of chapter 121C of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 725 of the acts of 1972, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 7 and 8, the words ", redevelopment and general, and rehabilitation of structures, and such development".

Chap. 281. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A FINE FOR WILFUL AND MALICIOUS SETTING FIRE TO A DWELLING HOUSE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1 of chapter 266 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 43 of the acts of 1948, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word "years", in line 11, the words:— , or by a fine of not more than ten thousand dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Chap. 282. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE LAW ESTABLISHING HISTORIC DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The first paragraph of section 3 of chapter 40C of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 359 of the acts of 1971, is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the following sentence:— The buildings, structures or sites to be included in the proposed historic district may consist of one or more parcels or lots of

land, or one or more buildings or structures on one or more parcels or lots of land.

Chap. 283 AN ACT MAKING A CORRECTIVE CHANGE IN THE LAW FURTHER REGULATING THE PRESERVATION OF HISTORICAL AND ARCHEOLOGICAL RESOURCES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to make forthwith a corrective change in the law further regulating the preservation of historical and archeological resources of the commonwealth, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 26 of chapter 9 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the fifth sentence, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 1155 of the acts of 1973, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:— The commission, the state archeologist and the board of underwater archeological resources established pursuant to section one hundred and seventy-nine of chapter six shall advise the state secretary on matters relating to the historical and archeological assets of the commonwealth and assist him in compiling and maintaining an inventory of such assets.

Chap. 284. AN ACT REACTIVATING A CERTAIN ELIGIBLE LIST FOR PROMOTION TO THE OFFICE OF CAPTAIN IN THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF CHELSEA AND EXTENDING THE TIME WITHIN WHICH IT SHALL BE EFFECTIVE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The eligible list for promotion to the office of captain in the fire department of the city of Chelsea which expired January eleventh, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, is hereby reactivated and extended for six months from the effective date of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 285. AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SOLICITATION OF VOTES AND THE DISTRIBUTION OF CAMPAIGN LITERATURE IN OFFICES USED FOR VOTER REGISTRATION.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 51 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
