RESOLVE VALIDATING THE ACTS OF EVELYN J. OLANDER OF NEWTON AS A NOTARY PUBLIC.

1 *Resolved*, That the acts of Evelyn J. Olander of
2 Newton as a notary public between August twenty-
3 sixth, nineteen hundred and forty-four, and February
4 twelfth, nineteen hundred and forty-eight, both days
5 inclusive, in so far as the same may have been invalid
6 by reason of the fact that, upon the change of her
7 name from Evelyn J. Bloomquist, she failed to re-
8 register under her new name and pay to the state
9 secretary a fee of one dollar as required by section
10 thirteen of chapter thirty of the General Laws, are
11 hereby confirmed and made valid.
