AN ACT AFFECTING OVERTIME COMPENSATION FOR POLICE OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 147 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 17D, the following new section:—
3 *Section 17E.* If an officer or member of the police force of
4 the police department of a city or town shall be required to be
5 on duty for any period in excess of his regular hours of duty as
6 from time to time established, he may be given time off equal
7 to such period of overtime duty or, if time off cannot be given
8 by reason of a personnel shortage or other cause, he may be
9 paid for such period of overtime duty at such an hourly rate as
10 may be determined by the authority in charge of a police de-
11 partment, which rate shall in no event be less than one and one
12 half of the basic hourly rate of his regular compensation for his
13 average weekly hours of regular duty.
