

HOUSE No. 5921

By Mr. Moriarty of Abington, petition of Paul F. X. Moriarty that Lawrence A. Cook shall, notwithstanding certain maximum age requirements, be made eligible for appointment as a police officer. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT LAWRENCE A. COOK SHALL, NOTWITHSTANDING CERTAIN MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS BE ELIGIBLE FOR APPOINTMENT AS A POLICE OFFICER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provision of any law or rule to the contrary
2 regulating the maximum age for applicants for appointment as a
3 police officer, the division of personnel administration shall certify
4 Lawrence A. Cook as a police officer, according to the grade he
5 received in the examination for said position held in nineteen
6 hundred and seventy-five, notwithstanding the fact that he has
7 attained the maximum age for said position since that time
8 provided that he fulfills all other requirements for certification as a
9 police officer.
