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### CHAP. XLII.

An Act to change the name of the town of Pegypscot.

**BE** it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, That the name of the town called Pegypscot, shall cease, and the said town shall hereafter be called and known by the name of Danville, the act of incorporation to the contrary notwithstanding.

[Approved by the Governor, February 1, 1819.]

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### CHAP. XLIII.

An Act to incorporate the Salem Laboratory Company.

SEC. 1. **BE** it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, That George S. Johannot, John Punchard, and Isaiah Hacker, and all such persons as may hereafter associate with them, their successors and assigns, being citizens of the United States, shall be, and they hereby are constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name of the Salem Laboratory Company; and by that name, may sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, defend and be defended, in any Courts of Record, or in any place whatsoever; and shall and may do and suffer all matters,
