**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act providing for a Bathing Beach and Other Recreational Facilities at Jeffries Point, East Boston, and for a Continuance of Dredging and Filling in that Locality.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston may purchase or  
2 lease from the commonwealth, and the common-  
3 wealth may sell or lease to said city, land now  
4 owned by the commonwealth and situated at  
5 Jeffries Point in that portion of said city known as  
6 East Boston, for the purpose of providing thereat  
7 suitable bathing beach and other recreational facili-  
8 ties.

1 SECTION 2. Whether or not such a sale or lease  
2 is consummated, the department of public works of  
3 the commonwealth is hereby authorized and  
4 directed to continue the dredging and filling hereto-  
5 fore carried on by it at said Jeffries Point but some  
6 time since discontinued.
