It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
of the State of Michigan, in the year of our Lord one  
thousand nine hundred and thirty and of our Independence  
the hundred and thirty-eighth, that the Constitution of  
the State of Michigan be and the same shall be printed  
and distributed to the several counties of the State.

That the Governor of the State of Michigan be and he  
shall be the printer of the Constitution of the State of  
Michigan, and that he do print and distribute the same  
to the several counties of the State, and that he do  
therein conform to the provisions of this act.
