AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT CLERK IN  
THE DISTRICT COURT OF WEST ROXBURY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 10 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as most re-  
2 cently amended by section 1 of chapter 148 of the acts of  
3 1974, is hereby further amended by striking out, in paragraph  
4 five, the words "municipal court of the West Roxbury dis-  
5 trict" and inserting in paragraph six after the words "cen-  
6 tral district court of Worcester" the words:— municipal court  
7 of the West Roxbury district.
