AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPLICATION OF SCHOOL BUILDING RENTALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section three of chapter forty as amended, most recently by
2 section six of chapter six hundred thirty-four of the Acts of
3 nineteen hundred and eighty-two, is further amended by strik-
4 ing out the second sentence of the second paragraph of said
5 section and inserting in its place the following sentence: — The
6 monies received from such rental or lease shall be kept
7 separate and apart from other city or town funds in the city
8 or town treasury by the treasurer and the principal and the
9 interest thereon may be expended by the school committee
10 without further appropriation for the upkeep of the facility in
11 which such surplus space is located and, to the extent not re-
12 quired for such purpose, for the purchase of necessary text-
13 books, equipment, supplies or other necessaries during the
14 fiscal year in which the monies are received; provided,
15 however, that any balance remaining in such account at the
16 close of a fiscal year shall be paid into the General Fund of
17 such city or town.
