AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE MUTUAL EXCLUSIVITY OF THE LAWS GOVERNING BUILDING CONSTRUCTION AND PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section thirty-nine M of chapter thirty of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by striking out the fourth sentence of subsection  
3 (a), and inserting in place the following sentence: — This  
4 paragraph shall not apply to the award of any contract subject  
5 to the provisions of sections forty-four A to forty-four G,  
6 inclusive, of chapter one hundred and forty-nine and every such  
7 contract shall continue to be awarded as provided therein, and  
8 provided, that none of the provisions of said sections forty-four  
9 A to forty-four G, inclusive, shall apply to any contract awarded  
10 under this section.
