AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WEYMOUTH TO CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Town of Weymouth is authorized to convey in fee, or such
2 lesser interest as may be required, to the Massachusetts Electric
3 Company, a certain parcel of land, together with structures there-
4 on, which the Town took by power of eminent domain for
5 conservation purposes on September 5, 1973, which parcel of land
6 is described as Parcel F in the Order of Taking dated September 5,
7 1973, and recorded on September 6, 1973 in Norfolk Deeds, Book
8 4979, Page 5.
