AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE OAK GROVE FARM IN THE TOWN OF MILLIS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Millis is hereby authorized to
2 transfer care, custody and control of a certain parcel of park land
3 known as the Oak Grove farm from the department of public
4 works to the Oak Grove farm commission to be managed and
5 operated as park and recreation land.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section fifty-
2 three of chapter forty-four of the General Laws of any other
3 general or special law to the contrary, the town of Millis is hereby
4 authorized to establish a separate fund which shall be kept
5 separate and apart from all other funds of said town by the
6 treasurer and in which shall be deposited all gifts and donations
7 made to the Oak Grove farm commission. Such funds and the
8 interest thereon shall be expended without further appropriation
9 by the said commission for the management, operation and
10 maintenance of the Oak Grove farm.
