AN ACT PROVIDING ONE DAY OFF IN SEVEN FOR MEMBERS  
OF THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN THE CITY OF  
BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 That policemen and firemen employed by the city  
2 of Boston shall have one day off in seven days pro-  
3 vided, however, that this act is adopted by the city  
4 council and signed by the mayor.
