RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL REVISIONS AND THE NECESSITY FOR CONSTITUTIONAL REVISIONS.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 six members of the senate to be designated by the president
3 thereof, nine members of the house of representatives to be
4 designated by the speaker thereof and six persons to be appointed
5 by the governor is hereby established for the purpose of making
6 an investigation and study relative to proposed constitutional
7 revisions and the need for revisions of the constitution. Said
8 commission shall be provided with quarters in the state house or
9 elsewhere, may hold public hearings, and may expend for clerical
10 and other services and expenses such sums as may be appro-
11 priated therefore. Said commission shall report to the general
12 court the results of its investigation and study and its recom-
13 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary
14 to carry its recommendations into effect by filing same with
15 the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the fourth
16 Wednesday of December in the current year.
