## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

AN ACT INCREASING THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF POLICE AND FIRE FIGHTERS IN TOWNS AND FIRE FIGHTERS IN DISTRICTS WHO RETIRE UNDER THE VETERANS' RETIREMENT LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 58C of chapter 32 of the General Laws,  
2 inserted by chapter 400 of the acts of 1967, is hereby amended  
3 by inserting after the word "city", in line 1, the words: — , town,  
4 or district.

1 SECTION 2. In any town or district which accepts section  
2 fifty-eight C of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, as  
3 amended by section one of this act, if any veteran who was re-  
4 tired under the provisions of section fifty-eight of said chapter  
5 thirty-two, was at the time of his retirement a member of the  
6 police department or a permanent member of the fire depart-  
7 ment prior to the date of such acceptance, he shall have his  
8 retirement allowance adjusted so as to conform, from and after  
9 the date of such acceptance, to the provisions of said section  
10 fifty-eight C.
