AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF SEPTIC SYSTEM INSTALLERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 21A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 13A the following section:—
- 3 No person shall install septic systems without obtaining a
- 4 license from the department of environmental protection. Said
- 5 department shall establish standards for the issuance of said
- 6 licenses. The possessor of such license shall be permitted to
- 7 install septic systems in any city or town without further licenses
- 8 or permits from such city or town.
