### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

SENATE, July 23, 1969.

1 *Ordered*, That a joint special committee to consist of three  
2 Senators to be designated by the president of the Senate and  
3 six Representatives to be designated by the speaker of the  
4 House of Representatives, be established for the purpose of  
5 recommending a new division of the commonwealth into  
6 councillor and senatorial districts, under the provisions of the  
7 Constitution and in conformity with the laws of the common-  
8 wealth and with the decisions of the federal and state courts.

9 The committee may hire clerical, legal and such other as-  
10 sistance as may be necessary; and may expend for said pur-  
11 pose and other expenses of said committee such sums as may  
12 be necessary.

13 The committee shall be provided with quarters in the state  
14 house and shall be entitled to receive from the state secretary  
15 and any other election officials such data and information in  
16 their possession as may be of assistance to the committee.

17 The committee may report to the General Court from time  
18 to time but shall make its final report by filing the same with  
19 the Clerk of the Senate not later than second Wednesday in  
20 January in the year nineteen hundred and seventy, together  
21 with drafts of legislation as may be necessary to comply with  
22 the provisions of the General Laws, the Constitution and with  
23 the decisions of the federal and state courts, in relation to the  
24 aforesaid matters.
