By Mr. Bohigian of Worcester, petition of Robert J. Bohigian for legislation to place the office of supervisor of budgets of the city of Boston under the civil service law. Local Affairs.

AN ACT PLACING THE OFFICE OF SUPERVISOR OF BUDGETS OF THE CITY OF BOSTON UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The office of supervisor of budgets of the city
2 of Boston shall, upon the effective date of this act, be subject
3 to the civil service laws and rules, and the tenure of any in-
4 cumbent thereof shall be unlimited, subject, however, to said
5 laws and rules.

6 The incumbent of said office on said effective date shall be
7 subjected to a qualifying examination for such office by the
8 division of civil service. If said incumbent passes said exam-
9 ination he shall be certified for said office without serving any
10 probationary period, and his tenure of office shall be un-
11 limited, subject, however to the provisions of said laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance
2 in the current year by vote of the city council of said city,
3 subject to the approval of the mayor, but not otherwise.
