## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE REINSTATEMENT OF RAYMOND W. SCHLAPP AS A MEMBER IN SERVICE IN THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 In view of his long and meritorious service as a legislator,  
2 clerk of court and a veteran of W.W. II Raymond W. Schlapp  
3 may become a member in service of the contributory retire-  
4 ment system, for public employees, provided that he pays into  
5 said system the total amount required to receive credit for all  
6 of his creditable years in the public service, and elective office  
7 in one sum, and that the retirement benefits will begin on  
8 January 1, 1972.
