AN ACT RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS FROM TAXATION
GRANTED SOLDIERS AND SAILORS AND THEIR WIVES,
WIDOWS, FATHERS OR MOTHERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 3 of chapter 534 of the acts of 1949, inserted
2 by chapter 165 of the acts of 1950, is hereby amended
3 by striking out, in line 3, the word "forty-nine" and
4 inserting in place thereof the word:— fifty, — and
5 by striking out, in line 5, the word "fifty" and in-
6 serting in place thereof the word:— fifty-one, — so
7 as to read as follows:— *Section 3.* This act shall
8 be applicable to taxes levied in the year nineteen
9 hundred and fifty, and application for abatement or
10 exemption thereof may be made not later than October
11 first, nineteen hundred and fifty-one, notwithstanding
12 any provision of law to the contrary.
