Bill accompanying the petition of David Proudfoot and others for legislation to authorize the Third Congregational Society in Cambridge to convey certain property. Legal Affairs. January 12.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

AN ACT

To authorize the Third Congregational Society in Cambridge to Convey Certain Property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Third Congregational Society in Cam-
2 bridge, by the standing committee of said society or a
3 majority of them, is authorized to convey to such person
4 or persons as the society at a regularly called meeting
5 may designate, all that certain parcel of real estate with
6 the church and other buildings thereon situate, bounded
7 and described as follows: southwesterly by Austin street,
8 in the city of Cambridge, one hundred and eight feet;
9 northwesterly by land formerly of Bangs, one hundred
10 and twenty-one feet; northeasterly by land of persons un-
11 known, one hundred and eight feet; southeasterly by and

12 formerly of Muzzey, one hundred and twenty-five feet ;
13 or however otherwise the said church property may be
14 bounded or described. Said conveyance is to be made
15 in such form as the said society may deem expedient, and
16 the title to be conveyed is to be free of any trust, eccle-
17 siastical or otherwise, that may have been hitherto exist-
18 ing. The purchaser of said property is expressly exempted
19 and declared free of any responsibility or liability for the
20 application of the purchase money by the said society.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
