AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE OPENING OF EACH SCHOOL DAY WITH
A PERIOD OF SILENT MEDITATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 1 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 1A.* The school day in all public schools shall com-
- 4 mence with a period of silent meditation.
