## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

### AN ACT TO PROVIDE TWO ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT CLERKS IN THE WORCESTER SUPERIOR COURT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 221 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out section 4, as most recently amended by section 1  
3 of chapter 354 of the acts of 1955, and inserting in place thereof  
4 the following section: —

5 *Section 4.* The justices of the supreme judicial court shall  
6 appoint for a term of three years from the date of their  
7 appointment, and may remove, assistant clerks of courts, as  
8 follows:

9 For the county of —

10 Barnstable, an assistant;

11 Bristol, an assistant, and a second assistant;

12 Essex, an assistant, a second assistant, a third assistant,  
13 a fourth assistant and a fifth assistant;

14 Hampden, an assistant, a second assistant and, subject to  
15 the approval of the county commissioners, a third assistant;

16 Middlesex, an assistant, a second assistant, a third assist-  
17 ant, a fourth assistant and a fifth assistant;

18 Norfolk, an assistant;

19 Plymouth, an assistant;

20 Suffolk, an assistant of the supreme judicial court;

21 Worcester, an assistant, a second assistant, a third assist-  
22 ant, a fourth assistant, a fifth assistant, a sixth assistant and  
23 a seventh assistant.

24 Assistant clerks of courts except in Suffolk county shall act  
25 as assistant clerks of the supreme judicial court, the superior  
26 court and the county commissioners.
