## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Nine.

AN ACT TO FACILITATE AND EXPEDITE THE GRANTING OF ASSISTANCE TO INDIVIDUALS AND MAKING MORE ADEQUATE EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES AVAILABLE TO MEN AND WOMEN OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

1    *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to de-  
2 feat its purpose, which is to facilitate and expedite the granting  
3 of assistance to individuals and making more adequate educa-  
4 tional opportunities available to men and women, therefore it  
5 is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the  
6 preservation of the public convenience and welfare.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1    There is hereby authorized to be paid from the treasury of  
2 the commonwealth to each educational institution of the com-  
3 monwealth such sum or sums, subject to availability of appro-  
4 priations, as may be necessary to meet the commonwealth's  
5 share of funds required under the provisions of Title II of the  
6 National Defense Education Act of 1958 (Public Law 85-864).  
7 Said funds shall be received and administered by said educational  
8 institutions in accordance with said National Defense Educa-  
9 tion Act and the regulations prescribed thereunder.
