### AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN SENIOR CITIZENS FROM PAYING FOR MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE AND REGISTRATION RENEWAL FEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 33 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by section 64 of chapter 653 of the acts of 1989, is hereby
- 3 further amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 Notwithstanding the above any person sixty-three years of age
- 5 or older, who provides proof of a twenty-five year record of safe
- 6 driving shall be exempt from paying any fee for the renewal of
- 7 a motor vehicle registration or the renewal of a license to operate.
