AN ACT DEFINING TESTING METHODS FOR LEAD PAINT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 3 paragraph the following sentence: — Testing methods used by
- 4 private inspectors shall be limited to those approved by the
- 5 Department of Housing and Urban Development.
