RESOLVES

IN SENATE, February 25, 1860.

The Committee on Education, to whom was recommitted the Resolves making certain appropriations from the income of the Massachusetts School Fund, report the accompanying Resolves.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty.

R E S O L V E S

Making certain Appropriations from the Income of the Massachusetts School Fund.

Resolved, That the sum of fourteen thousand and five hundred dollars be allowed and paid for the support of the four state normal schools, for the current year, under the direction of the board of education.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid to the Massachusetts State Teachers' Association, the sum of three hundred dollars, on condition that said association shall furnish a copy of the Massachusetts Teacher to each school committee in the several cities and towns of the state, during the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty, and furnish satisfactory evidence thereof to the auditor of the Commonwealth.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid in the month of August one thousand eight hundred and sixty, to the president or treasurer of the Massachusetts Teachers' Association, the sum of three hundred dollars, to be applied to the purposes of said association.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars be allowed and paid to the American Institute of Instruction, and that the

said sum be paid to the president or treasurer of said institute in the month of August next.

Resolved, That the sum of five thousand five hundred dollars be allowed and paid to enable the board of education to defray the expenses of the educational department for postage, printing, binding, advertising, stationery, meteorological observations, and all other incidental expenses of the board of education, or of the secretary thereof, and also for any contingent expenses of the normal schools not otherwise provided for.
