AN ACT

Relative to the Boston Transit Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The term of office of the members
2 of the Boston transit commission is hereby ex-
3 tended for three years from the first day of July
4 in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.

1 SECTION 2. The powers, duties and compen-
2 sation of said commission and of the members
3 thereof during said term of five years shall be the
4 same as are specified and provided in chapter five
5 hundred and forty-eight of the acts of the year
6 eighteen hundred and ninety-four and in acts in
7 amendment thereof or in addition thereto; and
8 any vacancy occurring in said commission shall
9 be filled in the manner provided in said chapter
10 five hundred and forty-eight.

11 Said compensation and the expenses incurred
12 by said commission shall be paid as provided in
13 said chapter five hundred and forty-eight and in
14 acts in amendment thereof or in addition thereto.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
