AN ACT

Relating to the Transportation of Baggage on Railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECT. 1. It shall be the duty of all Railroad Cor-
2 porations in this Commonwealth to give checks, when
3 requested to do so, to passengers over the roads of
4 said corporations, for the baggage of such passengers
5 when delivered for transportation, and such baggage
 shall be delivered to such passenger upon the sur-
7 render of said check; and any such corporation re-
8 fusing to comply with the requirements of this Act,
9 shall forfeit the sum of ten dollars.
