AN ACT INCREASING THE REGISTRATION FEE FOR BEAUTY SHOPS WHICH LEASE BOOTHS THEREIN TO HAIRDRESSERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 87CC of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as  
2 amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end the  
3 following sentence: — Any shop which leases booths to hair-  
4 dressers shall pay a fee of twenty-five dollars for the registra-  
5 tion of such shop. The booth owners shall pay the regular  
6 shop fee.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT PASSED IN THE YEAR 1848, RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF DEEDS.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Council, that the following be and they are hereby enacted, to amend an act passed in the year 1848, relative to the registration of deeds, to-wit:

That the words "and the register shall file a copy of the same in the office of the register" in the said act, be and they are hereby amended so as to read "and the register shall file a copy of the same in the office of the register, and shall also file a copy of the same in the office of the clerk of the court in which the same are recorded."
