AN ACT TO STUDY EFFECTS OF FILLING IN BIRD ISLAND FLATS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The State Department of Natural Resources is hereby
2 directed to carry out a study concerning the ecological effects
3 on Boston harbor of filling in the Bird Island Flats area. The
4 effect of such activity on the quality of water at Shays Beach
5 in East Boston shall be of special attention. A report shall be
6 filed with the legislature no later than January twentieth,
7 nineteen hundred and seventy-one. Until such a report is filed
8 all filling in the designated area shall be suspended.

The Constitution of the State

Article I. Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

But no Representative shall be chosen for a Term longer than two Years; and no Person shall be Representative who shall not, when elected, have attained to the Age of twenty five Years, seven Years being full of Age, and seven Years a Citizen of the United States, and when elected shall have been seven Years a Citizen of the State in which he shall be chosen.

Representatives and Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature. No Person shall be Representative who shall not, when elected, have attained to the Age of twenty five Years, seven Years being full of Age, and seven Years a Citizen of the United States, and when elected shall have been seven Years a Citizen of the State in which he shall be chosen.
