### AN ACT

Relative to the Number of Licenses of the Second Class to be granted to Innholders in Certain Cities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. In every city having more than  
2 one hundred thousand inhabitants, in which licen-  
3 ses for the sale of intoxicating liquors are granted,  
4 the number of licenses of the second class granted  
5 to innholders shall be not less than one to every  
6 ten thousand inhabitants, provided that proper  
7 applicants for such licenses are sufficient in num-  
8 ber for such a proportion.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
