## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-four.

### AN ACT

To legalize and confirm Certain Proceedings of the Town  
of Cummington.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The action of the town of Cummington  
2 relative to the appropriation of money for telephone ser-  
3 vice taken at the meeting of said town held on the tenth  
4 day of June in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-  
5 three is hereby legalized and confirmed, but nothing  
6 herein contained shall authorize or empower said town to  
7 construct or maintain a telephone line.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
