AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Payment of Annuities and Pensions to Soldiers and Others.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the payment of annuities and pensions due
5 from the commonwealth to soldiers and others
6 during the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day
7 of November, nineteen hundred and twelve, to
8 wit:—

9 For annuities, the sum of fifty-six hundred and
10 sixty-four dollars. (Res. 1874, ch. 83; 1885, ch.

15 1908, ch. 21; 1909, chs. 4, 20, 21, 86 and 95; 1910,

17 For pensions, the sum of two hundred and
18 eighty dollars. (Res. 1869, ch. 83; 1870, ch. 64.)
(Appropriation 1911, \$280.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
