AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE INCLUDED UNDER COLLECTIVE BARGAINING LAW FOR MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES AS PERTAINS TO FIRE FIGHTERS.
