Resolve providing for an Investigation by the Trustees of the Boston Metropolitan District and the Boston Elevated Railway of the Cost and Advisability of Certain Rapid Transit Extensions and Improvements.

1 *Resolved*, That the trustees of the Boston metro-  
2 politan district and the Boston Elevated Railway  
3 are hereby authorized and directed to jointly con-  
4 sider the report of the trustees of the Boston metro-  
5 politan district to the transit council dated December  
6 twelve, nineteen hundred and thirty and printed as  
7 a part of senate document number four hundred and  
8 fifteen of nineteen hundred and thirty-one and report  
9 to the legislature whether in their judgment parts of  
10 said route one and two outlined in said report to the  
11 council can be constructed and used beneficially for  
12 service pending the completion of the two routes in  
13 their entirety.

14 Said trustees shall report to the general court the  
15 result of its investigation showing what, if any, parts  
16 of said routes could be initially constructed, the cost  
17 of the same and the benefits and savings, if any, that  
18 would result, together with drafts of such legislation  
19 as may be necessary to carry its recommendations  
20 into effect by filing the same with the clerk of the  
21 house of representatives on or before the first Wednes-  
22 day in December of the current year.
