AN ACT CHANGING THE METHOD OF FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE CHAPLAINS OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 3 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 14 and inserting in place thereof
3 the following section:—

4 *Section 14.* The chaplain of the senate and the
5 chaplain of the house of representatives shall each
6 receive such salary as may be established by the com-
7 mittee on rules of the senate or the committee on rules
8 of the house of representatives, as the case may be.
