## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT MEMBERS OF THE RESERVE POLICE FORCE OF THE CITY OF EVERETT WHO REFUSE TO ACCEPT APPOINTMENTS TO THE REGULAR POLICE FORCE OF SAID CITY THREE TIMES IN ANY PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS SHALL BE INELIGIBLE TO RETAIN MEMBERSHIP IN SAID RESERVE FORCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law, or rule or  
2 regulation of the civil service commission to the con-  
3 trary, any member of the reserve police force of the  
4 city of Everett who refuses to accept an offered ap-  
5 pointment to the regular force three times in any  
6 period of five years shall not be eligible to continue  
7 as a member of said reserve force and his name shall  
8 be removed from the list of reserve police officers.

By reading the petition of Lewis F. Woodbury's petition in  
 regard that members of the reserve police force of the City of Lowell  
 who refuse to accept appointments to the regular police force of said  
 City shall have in any five year period be eligible to re-appoint-  
 ment in said reserve force. Civil Service.

### The Commensurability of Expenditures

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT MEMBERS OF THE RESERVE  
 POLICE FORCE OF THE CITY OF LOWELL WHO REFUSE  
 TO ACCEPT APPOINTMENTS TO THE REGULAR POLICE  
 FORCE OF SAID CITY SHALL HAVE IN ANY PERIOD OF  
 FIVE YEARS BEING ELIGIBLE TO BE RE-APPOINTED  
 INTO SAID RESERVE FORCE.

As amended by the Senate and House of Representatives  
 in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
 same as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of law or rule or
- 2 regulation of the civil service commission in the non-
- 3 force, any member of the reserve police force of the
- 4 City of Lowell who refuses to accept an official ap-
- 5 pointment to the regular police force shall in any
- 6 period of five years shall not be eligible to continue
- 7 as a member of said reserve force and his name shall
- 8 be removed from the list of reserve police officers.
