RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS IN FAVOR OF IMMEDIATE PASSAGE OF A LAW TO GRANT A SPECIAL NAME TO A NEW UNITED STATES VETERANS' HOSPITAL.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the general court of Massachusetts
- 2 urges the Congress of the United States to enact forth-
- 3 with legislation that the new United States veterans'
- 4 hospital at the junction of South Huntington avenue
- 5 and Heath street in Boston be known as the General
- 6 George Patton hospital; and be it further
- 7 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions be sent
- 8 forthwith by the secretary of the commonwealth to
- 9 the president of the United States, to the presiding
- 10 officer of each branch of Congress, and to the members
- 11 thereof from this commonwealth.
