AN ACT PROVIDING FOR DISTINCTIVE NUMBER PLATES FOR CERTAIN POLICE OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as amended by  
2 section 139 of chapter 110 of the acts of 1993, is hereby further  
3 amended by inserting after the tenth paragraph the following para-  
4 graph: —

5 The registrar shall furnish at his office at no less than cost to  
6 police officers who are drug abuser resistance education officers,  
7 plates bearing the letters DARE suitable for attachment to a motor  
8 vehicle owned solely or in part by such officers.

The Constitution of the United States

in the Year of the Lord of our Salvation 1863

Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

Section 3. The Senate of the United States shall be composed of two Senators from each State, chosen by the Electors in each State, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

Section 4. The Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
