Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine.

AN ACT

Relative to Suits against Executors and Administrators.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter one hundred and  
2 forty-one of the Revised Laws is hereby amended by  
3 inserting after the word "commenced" in the third  
4 line the words:—and notice of the same filed with  
5 the register of probate,—so as to read as follows:—  
6 *Section 9.* An executor or administrator, after having  
7 given due notice of his appointment, shall not be held  
8 to answer to an action by a creditor of the deceased  
9 which is not commenced and notice of the same filed  
10 with the register of probate within two years from the  
11 time of his giving bond for the performance of his trust,  
12 except as hereinafter provided.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon the first  
2 day of September in the year nineteen hundred and  
3 nine.
