Colella and Angelo Cataldo (with the approval of the mayor and city council) for legislation to provide for the emergency operation of the Belle Isle Inlet pumping station by the Metropolitan District Commission. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY OPERATION OF THE BELLE ISLE INLET PUMPING STATION BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 16 of
2 Chapter 723 of the Acts of 1983 the Metropolitan District Com-
3 mission is hereby authorized and directed to operate the pump-
4 ing station at Belle Isle Inlet in the City of Revere when either
5 the Director of Civil Defense of the Commonwealth or the
6 Mayor of the City of Revere certify to the Commissioner of
7 the Metropolitan District Commission that flooding within the
8 City of Revere poses an imminent danger to the property or
9 life of the citizens of the City of Revere.

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
