By Mr. Kirby, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2086) of Frank R. Mazzilli and Edward P. Kirby for rights therein, to the town of Carver, for the purpose of public water supply services. State Administration.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONVEYING OF STATE LAND OR RIGHTS THEREIN, TO THE TOWN OF CARVER, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Department of Environmental Management, Water Re-
2 sources Division, is hereby authorized and directed to convey
3 state land or rights therein, to the Town of Carver, for the
4 purpose of public water supply services.
