AN ACT DESIGNATING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION SKATING RINK IN THE CHARLESTOWN DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON AS THE FREDERICK DOUGLAS EMMONS, JOHN GERALD HERRIGAN AND MATHEW J. O'NEIL RINK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 544 of the acts of 1966 is hereby amend-
2 ed by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place
3 thereof the following sentence:—The metropolitan district
4 commission skating rink in the Charlestown district of the city
5 of Boston shall be known and designated as the Frederick
6 Douglas Emmons, John Gerald Horrigan and Mathew J. O'Neil
7 Rink, in memory of Frederick Douglas Emmons, a veteran
8 of World War I, Seaman First Class John Gerald Horrigan and
9 Mathew J. O'Neil.

1 SECTION 2. A suitable marker bearing the name of Mathew
2 J. O'Neil shall be erected at said skating rink by said commis-
3 sion.
