AN ACT

To provide for continuing the Publication of the
Province Laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The governor and council shall
2 continue the publication of the province laws, in
3 the manner provided by chapter three hundred
4 and eighty-seven of the acts of the year eighteen
5 hundred and ninety-four. They shall supervise
6 the work and determine the scope of the refer-
7 ences and notes; and due regard shall be given
8 by them to the terms of chapter forty-three of
9 the resolves of the year eighteen hundred and
10 sixty-five, to uniformity of the work, to the
11 method of editing heretofore pursued, and to the
12 early completion of the work.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
