To accompany the petition of Edmund V. Lane and John E. Powers for legislation to establish the salary of the State Inspector. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-One.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE SALARY OF THE STATE INSPECTOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 69 of chapter 33 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 402 of the acts of
3 1947, is hereby further amended by striking out sub-
4 division (e) and inserting in place thereof the following
5 subdivision: —

6 (e) The state inspector, state ordnance officer, and
7 all other state staff corps and departmental officers
8 shall, under the direction of the adjutant general, have
9 such functions and perform such duties as in general
10 pertain to their respective offices as prescribed in
11 orders or regulations from time to time by the com-
12 mander-in-chief. Except when ordered on duty under
13 section eleven, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen or one
14 hundred and five the state inspector shall receive an
15 annual salary of four thousand dollars and the state
16 ordnance officer shall receive an annual salary of
17 fifteen hundred dollars.
