AN ACT TO FACILITATE THE SALE OF STATE AIDED PUBLIC HOUSING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The third paragraph of section 34 of chapter 121B of the General
- 2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out in the first sentence, the
- 3 words: — If the department shall determine that an acute shortage
- 4 of housing for veterans constituting a public exigency, emergency
- 5 or distress no longer exists in a particular city or town.

The House of Representatives of the United States of America, in Session assembled, do hereby pass the following resolution:

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

Article I, Section 8, Clause 3

And all laws shall be passed in the presence of a majority of the members of each House.

It is the duty of the President to see that the laws are faithfully executed.

The first part of the Constitution is the Preamble, which states the purpose of the government. The second part is the Declaration of Independence, which states the reasons for the separation from Great Britain. The third part is the Constitution itself, which sets out the structure of the government and the rights of the people.
