Accompanying the petition of the selectmen of the town of Belmont that said town be authorized to pay a sum of money to the mother of Charles Irving Lohr. Towns. April 6.

AN ACT

Authorizing the Town of Belmont to pay a Sum of Money to the Mother of Charles Irving Lohr.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Belmont may pay to Edith
2 A. Lohr of Belmont, mother and next friend of Charles
3 Irving Lohr, minor, for the use of the said Charles Irving
4 Lohr, a sum not exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars,
5 as compensation for injuries sustained by him in the
6 chemical laboratory of the Belmont high school on
7 October thirty-first, nineteen hundred and twenty-two.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its accept-
2 ance by the said town in town meeting.
